Terms of contract and warranty

The breeder guarantees that the puppy is of the Afghan Hound breed and will provide the buyer with the necessary documents for registration. The puppy is sold as a pet. The breeder guarantees that this animal has no genetic defects and no congenital diseases and this guarantee is valid for a period of TWO (2) years. If the puppy died and was diagnosed by a veterinarian with a congenital defect that caused death during this period, he would be replaced by a puppy of equal value. If the buyer refuses the replacement puppy, the seller will then make a refund of 50% of the purchase price. No compensation will be assumed for the processing costs by the seller. In the event of death, an autopsy conducted by the Hôpital Vétérinaire St-Hyacinthe is required and the costs will be borne by the buyer. This autopsy must clearly specify the cause of death. The animal must be clearly identified with its microchip number. The puppy will benefit from a guarantee of FOURTEEN (14) days after his departure from the breeding concerning viral diseases. The puppy must be diagnosed by a licensed veterinarian within FOURTEEN (14) days in order to validate this guarantee (at the expense of the buyer) and notify the seller as soon as he becomes aware. In the event of death, the preceding clauses will apply (autopsy by the Saint-Hyacinthe Veterinary Hospital). Proof of vaccination of other animals in the household may be required to validate this guarantee and it may be cancelled if they do not have their vaccines up to date. The buyer undertakes to provide all the required care to the puppy and not to change food during the warranty period. In the event that the seller is unable to deliver a puppy (e.g. accidental death), the buyer may choose another puppy or be reimbursed for his deposit. In the event of a lawsuit, a lawsuit or any claim in court, this action must take place in the judicial district of Quebec. The warranty is not transferable. If the buyer no longer wants to keep his dog, he has the obligation to contact the breeder so that he can help him find a family suitable for the dog.

At the departure of the puppy:

The breeder will deliver the animal in good health with his up-to-date vaccination record. The breeder will have the puppy vaccinated and dewormed before delivery and the buyer will be responsible for continuing vaccination and deworming according to the recommendations of his veterinarian afterwards. The buyer undertakes to have the puppy sterilized and not to breed. Sterilization is required, among other things, for health and behavioral reasons. When the puppy leaves, a non-breeding agreement is mandatory in order to validate this contract. The registration documents will be handed over following receipt of proof of sterilization from the buyer's veterinarian, who must include the microchip number.

I accept the terms of this contract and undertake to comply with them.

NON-REPRODUCTION AGREEMENT:

At the time of taking possession, the buyer accepts the following terms: the dog will not be used for breeding purposes, neither by him nor by any other person. If he subsequently sells or transfers the dog, he undertakes to require the new owner to sign an agreement identical to it, and he will immediately send to the breeder. In addition, the buyer acknowledges that if the dog is used for breeding purposes, either accidentally or deliberately, thus going against the commitment of non-reproduction:

(a) No offspring of the dog will be eligible for registration in the CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) or AKC (American Kennel Club) registries; (b) Such offspring cannot be represented as purebred; (c) Any person who sells such offspring will be found guilty of violating the *Animal Pedigree Act*; and (d) The buyer will have to pay a fee of \$12,000.00 per dog acquired that will be demanded by the breeder from the buyer as a penalty, which penalty, the buyer agrees to pay and remit to the breeder.

If the dog is subsequently sold by the buyer, the seller hereby asserts its right to require that its permission be sought before cancelling this agreement.
